

CLEANUP TIPS:

- Take a hat or visor, insect repellent and sunscreen.
- Wear comfortable old clothes, you'll probably get dirty.
- Wear gloves provided.
- Don't go barefoot! Wear close toe shoes that you won't mind getting wet.
- Don't wade into a waterway unless you wear a lifejacket and know the depth of the water.
- Watch out for poison ivy, poison oak and snakes.
- Avoid injured animals as they may bite or be infected. Alert your site coordinator.
- **DO NOT** touch medical waste, chemical containers or barrels, pesticides or other dangerous items. Note their location and tell your site coordinator, who'll contact the proper authorities.
